ICA Building Contractor Dues are based on Indiana volume. Up to a 50% reduction in dues is offered for those Building Contractors that pay into CAPCI. To calculate your dues reduction, determine your ICA dues (based upon your most-recently completed fiscal year) and subtract the amount you paid into CAPCI during 2011. This is a dollar-for-dollar reduction, up to a maximum of 50% of your annual ICA dues.

### Associated General Contractors (AGC) of America

AGC of America is an organization of qualified construction contractors and industry-related companies dedicated to skill, integrity and responsibility. The full range of services offered to members helps to improve the quality of construction and protect public interest. AGC works to educate the industry to employ the finest skills, promote the use of the latest technology and advocate building the best quality projects for public and private owners. ICA is the state chapter of this national association; payment of AGC dues is required of all ICA members and is included in the dues calculation formula. 8.57% of the AGC of America dues is not deductible in accordance with IRC Sec 6033.

### Public Works Assessments

ICA invoices all Highway, Heavy & Utility Division members monthly for assessments on public works contracts awarded based on the following formula:

The first \$2,000,000 of fiscal year contract volume = .20 of 1%  
The second \$3,000,000 of fiscal year contract volume = .10 of 1%  
Fiscal year contract volume in excess of \$5,000,000 = .05 of 1%

ICA currently applies a 25% discount to amounts invoiced for assessments on public works contracts. This is subject to review by the Board of Directors.

### American Road & Transportation Builders Association (ARTBA)

ICA is the Indiana chapter of this Washington-based national association that advocates strong federal investment in transportation infrastructure. Contractors and subcontractors may join for an annual membership fee of \$1,210; associates may join for an annual membership fee of \$430.
